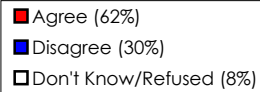
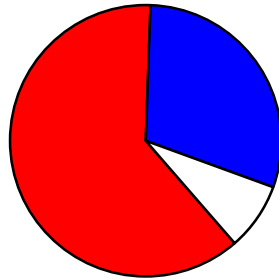


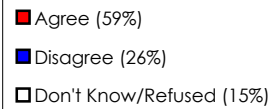
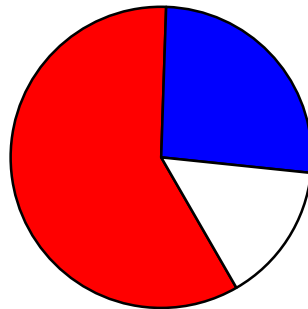
Poll: Voters Support Affordable Housing

There is a shortage of housing that low income people, that is, people on fixed incomes or low wage earners, in MY community can afford to rent.



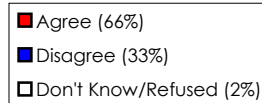
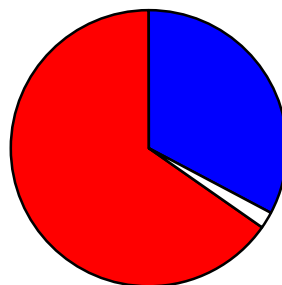

Congress spending more money to make sure low income people have housing they can afford to rent is more important than Congress cutting more taxes.



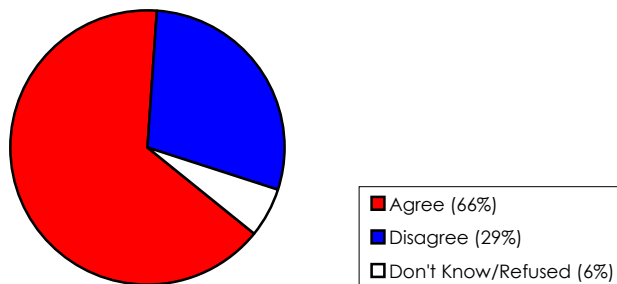
